Salmon fishing: Late July, or early August, 2026. Crabbing: October, November or December of 2025.

Snacks, drinks, and all necessary fishing or crabbing gear will be provided. With safety as a priority, Clay will provide an auto-inflatable personal floatation device (PFD) for each person. Guests are responsible for bringing appropriate layers of clothing, including rain gear, and a valid fishing/shellfish license.









Trip Value: A ½-day trip like this in Oregon typically costs \$200-\$300 per person. While Clay isn't a commercial guide, his years of experience and knowledge of the river make this a unique opportunity.
